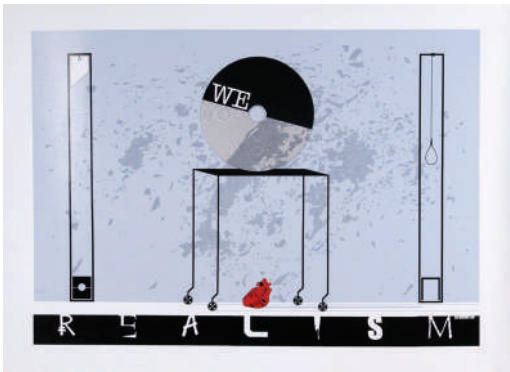

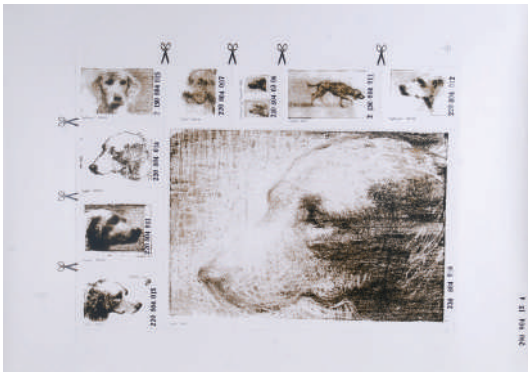

თანამედროვე ხელოვნება თანამედროვე სივრცეში

პრინტის საერთაშორისო ფესტივალი LIFE-N-STYLE 2016 17 აგვისტოს ბათუმში გაიხსნება და შემდგომ საქართველოს სხვა ქალაქებში გადაინაცვლებს. მისი ბოლო გაჩერება თბილისშია.

Handmade print - ხელით ბეჭდვა თანამედროვე ვიზუალური ხელოვნების, კრეატიული ინდუსტრიისა და არტბიზნესის ერთ-ერთი მნიშვნელოვანი დარგია. მთელ მსოფლიოში ხელით ბეჭდვა მაღალ დონეზე განვითარებული. საერთაშორისო ფესტივალების, ბიენალების მეშვეობით მიმდინარეობს ამ დარგის მუდმივი პოპულარიზაცია. მაშინ როდესაც პრინტი საქართველოში მხოლოდ იაფფასიან პროდუქციასთან ასოცირდება.

პრინტის კვირეული, მხატვრების, კოლექციონერების, სპეციალისტებისა და მოყვარულების შემოქმედებითი სინთეზის კარგი საშუალებაა. მნახველებს შეუძლიათ ასოციაცია „არტ კავკასიის“ მიერ წარმოდგენილი კოლექცია არა მარტო საექსპოზიციო სივრცეში, არამედ საზოგადოებრივი თავშეყრის ადგილებში დაათვალიერონ - ქუჩის გალერეის სახით.

ხელით ბეჭდვა ნამუშევრების მცირე ტირაჟირების საშუალებას იძლევა და მათგან ყველა ორიგინალია. სხვადასხვა თაობის ადგილობრივი და უცხოელი ნამყვანი მხატვრები სპეციალურად ფესტივალისთვის ქმნიან ნამუშევრებს, რომელთა ფასი ხელმისაწვდომი იქნება მსურველთათვის.

LIFE-N-STYLE - ფესტივალის კონცეფციაა, რაც თანამედროვე ხელოვნების ახალ ინტერიერებში შეღწევისა და თანამედროვე ცხოვრებაში ინტეგრირებას ითვალისწინებს. პრინტი და ტექსტილი - ამ თემას უკვე რამდენიმე წელია აქტიურად იყენებენ ტანსაცმლისა და გამოყენებითი ხელოვნების დიზაინში. გამოფენის პარალელურად იგეგმება პრინტის ტექსტილისა და კერამიკის სინთეზის პრეზენტაცია.

პროექტს საპასუხისმგებლო მისია აკისრია: გამოავლინოს ხელით ბეჭდვის საუკეთესო ასპექტები, პრესტიჟული გახადოს ღონისძიება და ხელოვნების ამ დარგისადმი ინტერესი გაუღვივოს საზოგადოებას.

Supporting the interest in all artistic expressions and to make the event prestigious is the target mission of the project.

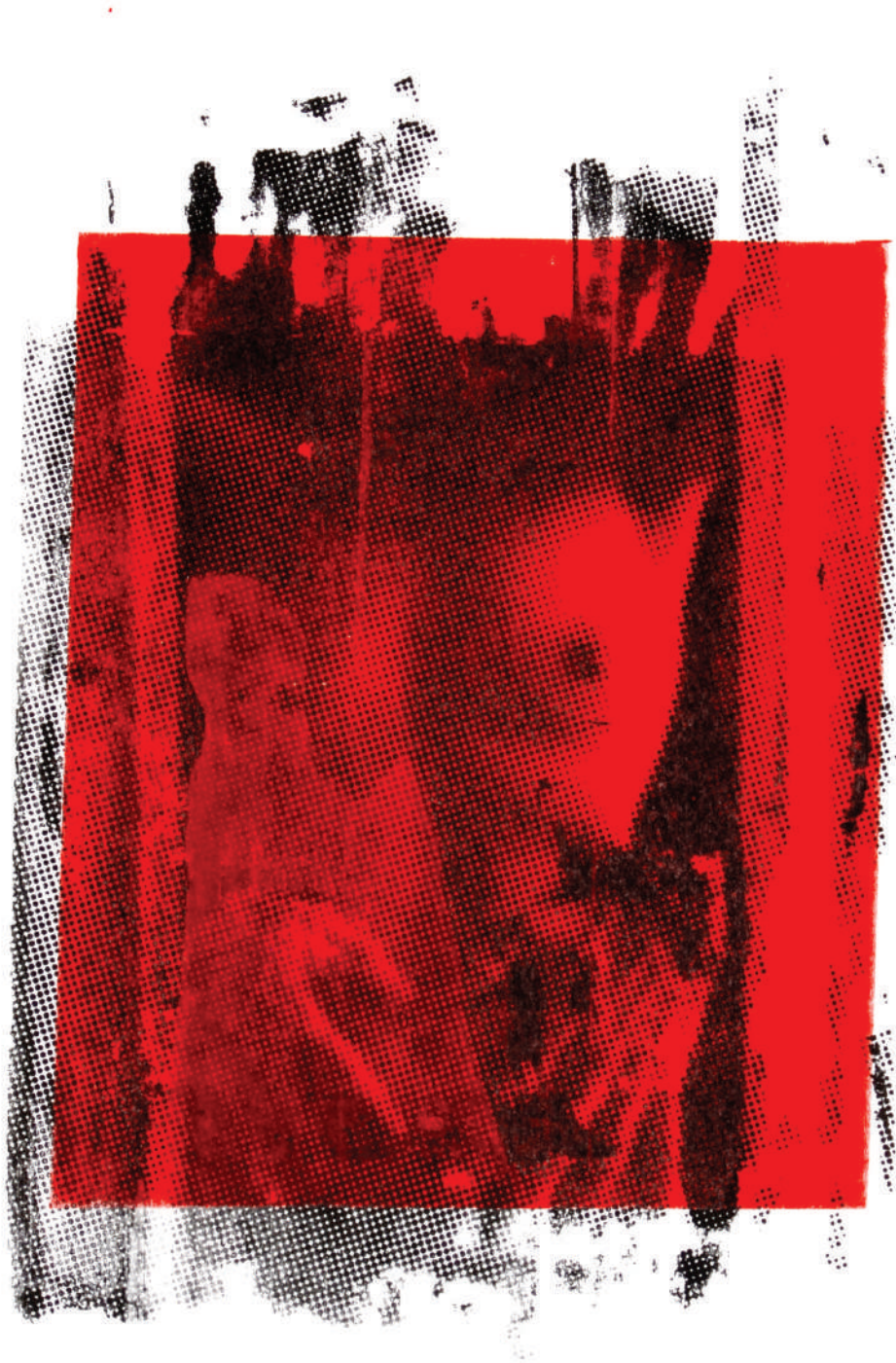
